

Cheshire Wildcat Scholarship

Applicants will be considered eligible to apply for a scholarship if they plan to pursue education beyond the high school level (trade school, apprenticeship, community college, four-year college or university). Applicants must have played in the Wildcat organization for all four years of high school and currently still be on a Wildcat team. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher and demonstrate good sportsmanship, citizenship, high moral character, and potential for leadership and academic success. Cheshire Wildcat Scholarships are determined by the Wildcat Board and are awarded annually.

Funds Available: (2) \$500 scholarships for Cheshire residents at CHS (apply through the school) and (2) \$500 Scholarships for out-of-town residents will be awarded to athletes graduating in 2023.

How to apply: Each applicant must complete the Cheshire Wildcat Softball Application, which is available on the Cheshire Wildcat website. In addition, please provide a typewritten response of at least 100 words, no more than 500, which answers the following question.

How has softball impacted your life?

You may write about your experience playing for the Cheshire Wildcats or your softball experience in general. You may wish to write about what you have gained or learned from the sport and your coaches and / or how while playing softball the experiences have helped to shape you as a teammate and leader.
